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## COLOMBIA

The Republic of Colombia is the fourth largest country in South America, with about 1.139.000 square kilometers of territory. It is the only South American nation that borders both the Atlantic and Pacific oceans, allowing it to have 2.900 kilometers of coast.

The Colombian national territory also includes three branches of the Andes mountain range and a wide range of thermal floors and agricultural conditions that are distributed in 6 regions, 32 departments and 1.102 municipalities.



# Academic information



## Education system

Class attendance is mandatory. Undergraduate courses (Bachelor's degree) are offered from Monday to Saturday during daytime and nighttime.

The semester has three (3) evaluation periods:  
First midterm exams - weeks 5 and 6  
Second midterm exams - weeks 10 and 11  
Final exams - weeks 17 and 18

Although most courses are in Spanish, you have the option of taking courses in English.

## Grading system

The grading scale in Colombia ranges from 0 to 5.



0	-	2,9	Failed
3,0	-	3,5	Acceptable
3,6	-	4,0	Good
4,1	-	4,5	Outstanding
4,6	-	5,0	Excellent

## Academic calendar

Every semester has a duration of 18 weeks and is scheduled in the following way:

- Semester 1: January - June
- Semester 2: July - December



## Academic credits

In one semester an international student should take courses for approximately 18 Colombian credits.


One (1) academic credit is equivalent to 48 hours of work distributed as follows: 16 hours of lectures and 32 hours of independent study (class preparation, reading, etc.).\*

\* For reference: 1 European credit (ECTS) is equivalent to 1,7 Colombian credits

## Recommended academic workload

Students should register a minimum of 3 subjects and a maximum of 6. They can choose subjects from different programs but we recommend choosing at least 3 courses from the same program.

### Required documents:

#### To be sent by the home university:

- Letter of intent expressing interest in carrying out an exchange semester at Javeriana Cali
- Letter of academic recommendation from a professor
- Learning agreement
- Transcript of records (in Spanish or English)
- Spanish proficiency certificate, B1 level (Only applies to non-Spanish-speaking students)
- Copy of valid passport. If the student has Colombian nationality, please attached this passport.
- Photo in JPG format, with white or neutral background





## Admission and stay in Colombia

Students who will be in **Colombia for more than 180 days (6 months)** must apply for a visa type "V"..

For information about the **requirements and visa process**, the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Colombia ([www.cancilleria.gov.co](http://www.cancilleria.gov.co)) or a Colombian consulate close to the respective city of origin can be consulted.

For those **nationalities that do not require a Colombian visa, at the moment of entering the country**, students must present the letter of acceptance for the exchange semester upon entering the country in order to be stamped on their passport "PID Entry Permit". The Permit is valid for 90 days and should be renewed for a further 90 days.

## Health insurance

Students are responsible to acquire medical insurance with comprehensive international coverage, repatriation due to accidents, illness or death, and civil liability to third parties. We recommend that the students familiarize themselves with the terms and conditions of their insurance prior to arrival.

Javeriana Cali does not offer own accommodation. However, the International Office provides options for exchange students such as rooms in homestays, independent apartments, among others. An option close to the campus is Inside by Boho which offers shared apartments. .

## Airport transfer

Cali has an international airport located outside of the city. The University works with providers for transfer service to take students from the airport to their accommodation in Cali. The International Office can share contact details for contracting the service.



## Public transport

There is public transportation available (MIO and buses) that have a cost of \$ 3.500 COP per ride. Also, transportation applications like Uber, DiDi, etc. can be used.
